



If you have a favorite local nonprofit, event or artist, provide that information on the application.


#### What Are the Benefits?

Positive visibility offered through the Banner Project include:


- The image and message are visible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.




### 2024 New Bern Banner Project Sponsorship Form
